### **Writing Contest**

Categories:

- (1) Fiction
- (2) Nonfiction

Words:

Maximum 1,200

Format:

Electronic Word documents and/or hard copies will be accepted. On the first page place only the title, category, word count, author's name, addresses (both U.S. mail and e-mail), phone number, and your Social Security number (necessary for writing a check for your winning entry). Begin the manuscript on page 2. Do not put your name anywhere except on the first page, as the author's name will not be seen by the judges.

Deadline:

Entries must be postmarked by January 31, 2008.

Attendees at the 2008 Pentecostal Writers Institute

Prizes:

For each category: first place, \$75; second place, \$50; third place, \$25  
Winners will be announced Friday morning at the Pentecostal Writers Institute, March 12-14, 2008.

**RULES:**

1. Only two submissions (one fiction; one nonfiction) may be entered. All manuscripts will be considered for possible future publication by Word Aflame Publications.
2. All contest judges, PWI staff, and employees of Word Aflame Publications and members of their immediate families are not eligible to participate.
3. All submissions must be original and unpublished. (Articles that have been edited by members of the WAP or PWF staff will be not accepted.)
4. Manuscripts must be in 12 pt. font and double-spaced. Both electronic Word documents and hard copies will be accepted.
5. No poetry will be accepted.
6. Manuscripts, non-fiction or fiction, should be religious, stressing or illustrating biblical truths.

7. If an article/story is chosen for publication by WAP, the author will be paid according to the WAP payment rate.
8. Entries will be judged on the basis of writing skill, creativity, and subject matter.
9. Entries not meeting these guidelines will be rejected.

Reminder: You must be registered at the Pentecostal Writers Institute to be eligible for this contest. Submissions must be postmarked by January 31, 2008.
